The document was reviewed and the final draft will be reviewed by the States Attorney's office and brought back to the committee for approval. Also mentioned was that GIS information is exempt from FOIA requests.

The committee discussed the tax calculation support for the Treasurer, Clerk and Assessor. Lana Phillips stated that she was please with the progress so far.
