SUMMARY

Under general supervision of Animal Control Director, the Warden is responsible to explain and enforce State laws and County ordinances pertaining to the treatment and control of animals. Duties include feeding and caring for injured and impounded animals, licensing, rabies quarantine, impounding, disposing of animals, and street patrol.

This position is on-call every fourth week to respond to emergency call outs by the Sheriff's Office.
